Wandering Away: When Phoenix walks away from his group without notification.																																
Resistive Behavior: when Phoenix refuses to participate in activities or vocational tasks																																
Repeating Statements: Phoenix will repeat statements to let you know what he is fixating on.																																
Stealing: when Kitt attempts to steal or takes something that does not belong to him																																
Vocational Skills: completing a 1-3 step task, e.g., wiping table, cleaning area after eating, simple sorting, or choosing three numbers.																																
Premack: prompting Phoenix with “if you do” “then you’ll”																																
Request Break: When Phoenix requests to take a break																																
Prompting Level: (for requesting 1:1 time) V = verbal; G = gestural; P = physical; H = hand-over-hand
